The Sculptor! Whatshisname

Sebastian Burdon, known professionally as Whatshisname, is a Polish-born contemporary artist based in London who has been active for over fifteen years. He began creating digital art at just seven years old using an Atari 130 XE, crafting images pixel by pixel, what would now be called pixel art. After relocating to London in 2006, he worked under British artists as an assistant, refining his craftsmanship before launching his solo career. His work, sculptures, prints, and public art, spans cities like London, New York, Los Angeles, Hong Kong, and Singapore, and is noted for being playful, provocative, and pop-inspired. Burdon aims to reveal alternative modes of creative thinking, connecting preexisting ideas in novel ways, showing how simple concepts, when executed uniquely, can surprise and provoke.
